Nina Otero-Warren Quarter

The Nina Otero-Warren Quarter is the fourth coin in the American Women Quarters™ Program. Nina Otero-Warren was a leader in New Mexico's suffrage movement and the first female superintendent of Santa Fe public schools. She is the first Hispanic American woman to appear on US currency.

Otero-Warren strove to improve education for all New Mexicans and worked to advance bicultural education

and to preserve cultural practices among the state's Hispanic and Native American communities. In 1921, she became the first Hispanic woman to run for Congress.

This quarter's reverse (tails) features an image of Nina Otero-Warren on the left, flanked by three individual Yucca flowers – New Mexico's state flower.
