#### The 1943 Bronze Lincoln cent: A million dollar mistake

In 1943 there was a copper shortage due to World War II. The United States Treasury used zinc coated steel for the blanks of the Lincoln cent. The US Mint made a mistake and produced 15 bronze cents. The bronze mistakes are very rare and worth a lot of money. In 2018 a bronze 1943 penny sold for over 1 million dollars. In the next issue of the Pretty Penny, I will be writing about a more common minting mistake, the double die.

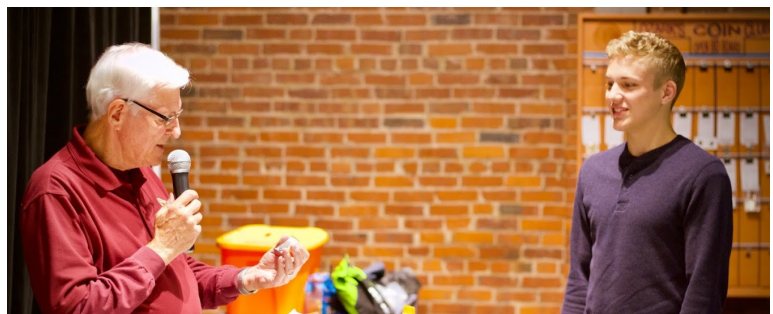
- Welcome new YN members: Gage G.; Hayleigh S.; Emma S.; and YN visitor Anthony G
