#### The Lincoln Cent Reverse

Last month, I wrote about how Abraham Lincoln's portrait was put on the cent in 1909. The head of a coin is called and obverse and the tail is called the reverse. The Lincoln head cent obverse is the longest minted coin in the US, the reverse has changed designs 4 times. In 1909 through 1958, the penny had a wheat ears reverse. From 1959 through 2008, the coin had the Lincoln Memorial reverse. In 2009, the reverse was the Bicentennial design, which featured 4 different designs, which I will write about in another article. Since 2010, the reverse of the cent has been the shield design. Next month, I will write more about the wheat ear reverse design.

Interesting Fact: In 2017, production figures show that Philadelphia and Denver mints produced more than 8 billion pennies.
